Tenor Choral Scholarships

2025 - 2026

Richmond Chamber Choir would like to appoint **two tenor choral scholars** for the **2025–6 season**. The choir is an auditioned chamber choir that performs music across the choral repertoire. Programmes for the upcoming season will cover a wide range of composers from Fauré to Duke Ellington.

The scholarships are designed for committed singers who wish to develop their ensemble singing within a secular context, to improve their sight-reading and broaden their knowledge of the choral repertoire. Opportunities will be given through solos, musical leadership and other areas of interest (like composition). The scholarships are open to anyone aged 18-30 in full or part-time education. An annual **bursary of £1200** will be paid across three terms.

Scholars are expected to attend weekly rehearsals at St John the Divine, Richmond on **Thursdays, 19:30-21:30**, and the 3-4 concerts the choir perform each year. These will be on 20th December 2025, 14th March and 4th July 2026.

Auditions will be arranged and will consist of two contrasting solo songs, a short choral piece (given in advance), sight-reading, range and aural tests and a short informal discussion.
